

Academic Qualification Details



NCFE **level 3** diploma(540) sport & physical activity(sports coaching)

- One year course with option of progressing on to level 3 extended diploma below
- 540 guided learning hours
- 12 hours of education per week
- 6 hours of football training(not including match days)
- 9 modules relating to physical education, ranging from anatomy and physiology to sport as a business
- Assessed through coursework across the 2 years
- Progress on to year 2 level 3 extended diploma if year 1 pass achieved




Step 3


Receive offer of a conditional place on the course
